

Slight variations in the oval glass shape are normal

This is a kiln-formed glass that goes through a dynamic stretching and pulling process that simpler shapes do not. To make the oval, the artisan heats the flat glass to over 1,200 degrees and then uses gravity to form it into a deep curve. Each piece of glass is unique, and slight variations in shape are a normal result of this process.
